



## HCPCS C-Code Use in the Outpatient Hospital Setting

There currently is no established HCPCS C-code to describe AGENT drug-coated balloon. Boston Scientific does not recommend the use of C2623 (Catheter transluminal angioplasty, drug-coated, non-laser) for a coronary drug-coated balloon. C2623 was established for reporting peripheral interventions.

The best match for AGENT would be codes:

- C2628 (Catheter, occlusion) or
- C1889 (implantable/insertable device, not otherwise classified)

Use of C2623 could have negative impacts on future reimbursement opportunities.
